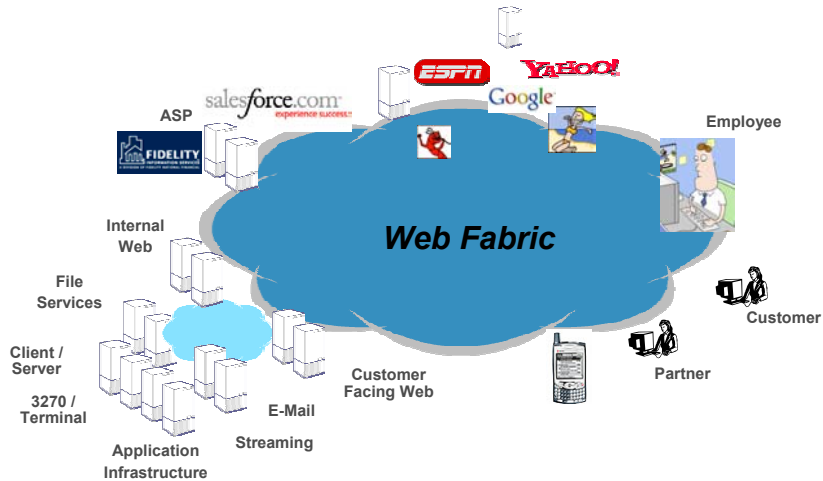

Common Themes

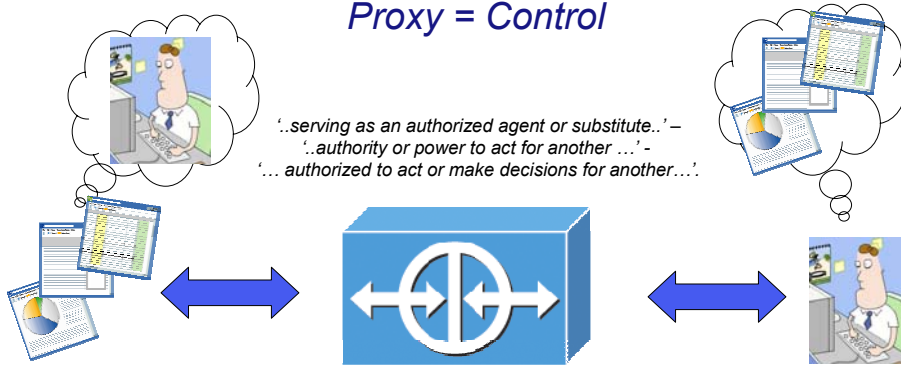
- A 'Web' Strategy (*Evolving*)

Proxy – Acts as a Client to a Server

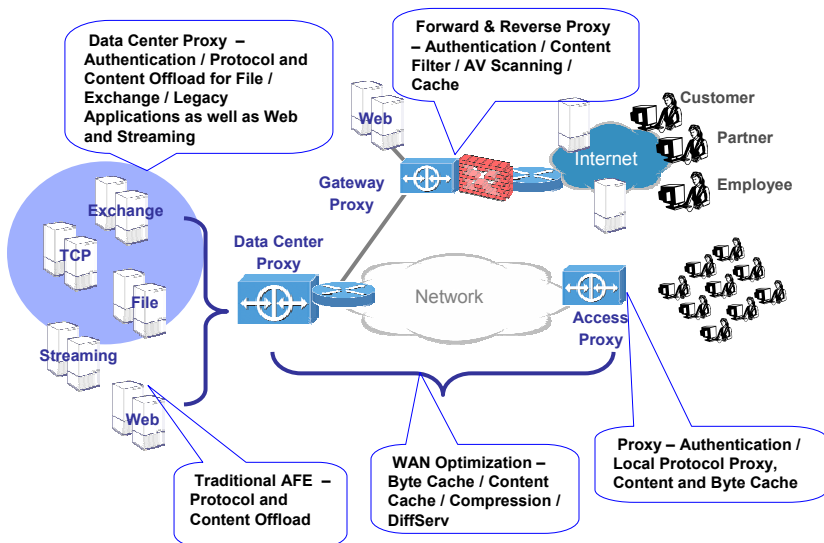
